



Report from Joe Bergh who is involved in the two way radio business for the past 38 years. He owns a dealership in Paarl under the name of J & B Electronics and runs a sales and service operation. As an avid super and adventure biker for the past 30 years or so he is an ideal candidate to test the new TRIBE launched by Interphone.

When the TRIBE group comms system was explained to him, he was very skeptical of the VOX (voice activated transmission) system in place of the traditional PTT (push to talk) button. However after testing he has the following remarks:

“TRIBE is the best group bike 2 bike communication I have ever experienced, and I have tried them all. The VOX system works extremely well due to the built in roger beep which is an audible signal which all riders hear when the channel is open and ready to be used for talking. The range achieved was excellent and total wireless operation was amazing”

Some tips to ensure excellent group comms:

Fit the radio into a GPS holder (available from BIKE2BIKE) on the handlebars

Before starting ride, the entire group must pair up and plug in and have a short comms practice run off the bike to ensure all riders see how the roger beep and VOX action work.
